### Under the statutes of the apprenticeship program, the student must:

- Attend classes at least twice a month.
- Pass the exams with a grade of 75%.
- Pay an administrative fee of \$ 40.00 for each class.
- The student must have their books at all times for the theory.
- The student must have their equipment at all times for practice.
- The student must wear their uniform at school at all times.
- It is required to start your entry and exit in the System by class.
- If you need to leave before the time of departure, a permit is required.

### Example of scoring:

If an exam has a total of 43 questions and the student gets 28 correct of the 43 questions, the 28, correct ones are divided among the total of the exam questions ( $28/43 = 65\%$ ). The final grade would be 65%. If the grade total goes above 5 the porting is rounded. Example: 0656, it would be 66%.
